“In Nomine Patris et Filii et Spiritus Sancti” Jesus Christ — the Son of God, the Word Made Flesh, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity — taught the unity of God as faith’s highest calling as he quoted the Shema (*Deuteronomy 6:4; St Mark 12:29*), “Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one.” Yet this one God, our Lord, is also taught by Jesus to have a threefold, trinitarian name: one name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This mystery is never clarified with a neat Bible verse to define the Trinity, yet throughout the New Testament this one God of Israel is continuously revealed in the singular communion of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit — three equal-yet-distinct personae of one eternal God. In the mystery of a relationship we learn more about God than in the clarity of reason & logic, a gracious gift to a humanity which is often more relationally revealed than logically consistent. God is Love; God is One; God is relational; God is with us; in God’s Holy Triune Name.

“Sealed with the Holy Spirit, Marked with the Cross of Christ” Confirmation affirms God’s loving baptismal promises for our maturing lives. As baptism is received by grace, so are we confirmed in grace to trust God’s bold presence with us in all things—which opens us to a faith that blesses God as the Love who first (*and most precious in Christ*) blesses us. As the Holy Spirit is confirmed for members of our community today, we all share in affirming the grace God pours upon us we thank God for this time to celebrate Christ’s love and grace for us all!

“But chiefly we are bound to praise” God for love and grace confirmed today in the lives of MacKenzie, Oliver and Noelle. These three are *soon-to-finish* middle school and have gathered over three years to study the Old and New Testaments and our Small Catechism, learning how to investigate God’s love through God’s Word and Sacraments, trusting them for grace.
