Joyful Generosity (Pink Envelopes): Our Joyful Generosity this month addresses the massive flood, caused by a collapsed glacier and its resulting landslide, that crashed across Nepal’s northern border on August 26, leaving a terrible wake of destruction. As Christians, we can’t look away when neighbors suffer. Lutheran Disaster Response (LDR) teams are already working with local and trusted partners to aid those who need it most, particularly families cut off from critical resources. Last month sent \$600 to GraceInside for prison ministry! Thanks!

Reforming Our St Mark Logo — “*In the beginning was the Logos*” comes from John 1:1 ... but, here at St Mark, our logo has generally come from the old flag of Venice (where the relics of St Mark are revered in its cathedral). The symbol of St Mark has long been a winged lion, but we have shifted over the years to emphasize a cross from that flag — *a more recognizable sign of Jesus’ church* — made by weaving latitude and longitude to stylize the globe (*even if it looks more like connected paperclips*). Today we refresh this icon of cross, highlighting our interconnections in Jesus, connected to our namesake’s older history, but unique to our St Mark congregation in Peninsula communities today.
